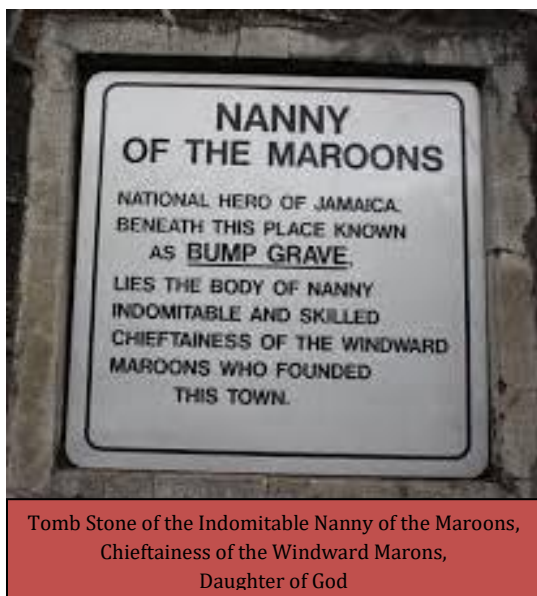

Historical Background

The indomitable Queen Nanny of the Maroons led her royal African battalion in a nine-year military contest (1729 – 1738) with King George II and his royal British regiment. At the end of the nine-year contest, King George II raised the white flag in surrender to Queen Nanny, thereby establishing the first Ghanaian African Queendom of the Diaspora on the Island of Jamaica.

The Indomitable Queen Nanny hails from Ghana's pre-1821 British colonial identity and, having never been colonised, returns to Ghana and continental Africa as a traditional landlord *dominus*.

Modern Day Leadership

The Queendom continues to enjoy a vibrant and important leadership role within the Diaspora today.

For more than 287 years, the descendants of Queen Nanny's realm has remained dedicated to African culture, history, economy, and financial integrity, while simultaneously maintaining peaceful diplomatic relations with the neighbouring societies, including Britain's monarch, and all surrounding sovereigns throughout the Americas.

The sovereign realm has not become a museum nor a static relic of the past. Today, while preserving its traditional culture and heritage, Moore Town is the headquarters to both the Economic Community of the Sixth Region and the African Diaspora Central Bank (ADCB), two of the most cutting-edge regional institutions driving modern Diaspora trade and finance with Africa.

Continental impact of the historic Queendom includes facilitating transactions in local African currencies using (AKL) LUMI. The Maroon money has already proven itself as the most stable of all African currencies during the period 2020 – 2025, and it has successfully advanced intra-African trade more than any other African currency during the same period.

Nanny Town does not have a ruling monarch; it has a resident descendant Maroon Rex.

HRM Rex Semako I & VI King Timothy Elisha Mc Pherson is a descendant of Nanny Town who has been honoured with many traditional kingships and chieftaincies across the continent of Africa and he is Chairman of the Sixth Region. He also serves locally as Plenipotentiary, as Conservator of Maroon Rights and Traditions, &c, &c.
